


The Christmas Play

twinkled above, casting a magical glow upon the winter wonderland that enveloped us.




A Christmas to Remember



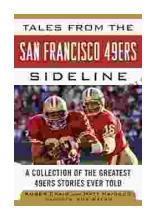
