Planning

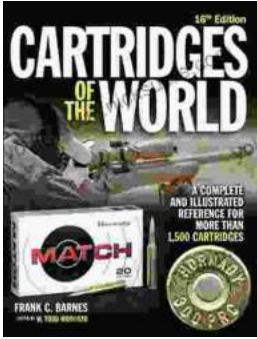

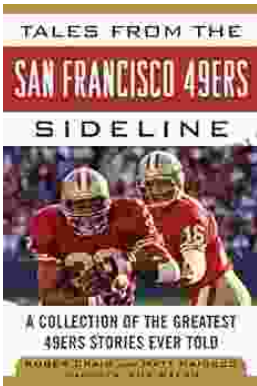
