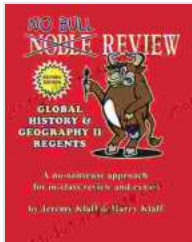

After the Exam

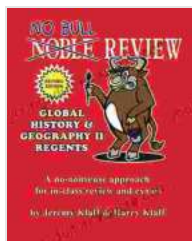
After you have completed the exam, you will need to submit your answer sheet to the proctor. The proctor will then score your exam and send your results to NYSED.

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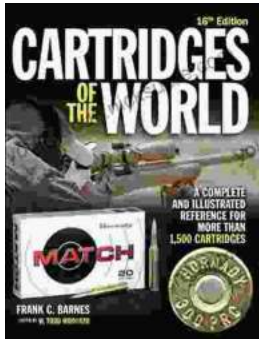
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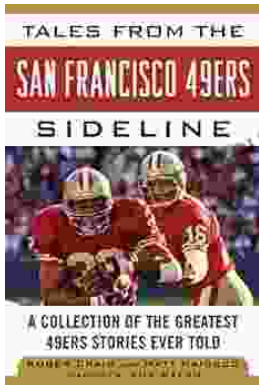
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
