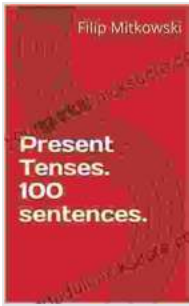

10. We *have not had* a break yet.

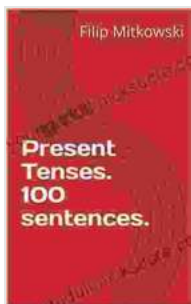
Uses of Present Perfect Tense

* Expressing actions or events that started in the past and continue to the present * Describing completed actions or events that are relevant to the present * Emphasizing the result or the effect of a past action or event in the present * Indicating experiences or accomplishments up to the present moment

Examples with All Three Tenses

1. *Usually*, I go to the gym (present simple) every Monday, but today I *am going* (present continuous) because I *have worked* (present perfect) out hard all week.
2. *Generally*, she *doesn't drink* (present simple) alcohol, but today she *is drinking* (present continuous) a glass of wine because she *has had* (present perfect) a stressful day.
3. *Typically*, we *watch* (present simple) movies on the weekends, but this weekend we *are watching* (present continuous) a documentary because we *have never seen* (present perfect) it before.
